



Bitterroot Frames and Publishing is happy to announce the return of the **Montana Miniatures** show for a third year. The overwhelming success of the 2017 and 2018 shows solidified a place in the art world for many years to come. We hosted the miniature show during the ***Out West Art Show and Sale*** at the Heritage Hotel in Great Falls.

Our plan from the beginning was to promote all of the artists in our show. We did this by going the distance with advertising in national publications, local art guides and a strong push with social media. We even published a catalog showcasing each piece of artwork, the artist and where that artist can be found during western art week in Great Falls. Using this aggressive plan, we sold an unprecedented 52% of our pieces in 2017 and topped that with 65% sales in 2018. Our sales model is Top Down! This means we sought out some of the biggest names in art and even several deceased pieces. Once again, we will have many Skull Society Artists and Cowboy Artists of America participating so get ready to see some more incredible works of art. We will also have some more deceased, high dollar pieces to attract some collectors. Our goal was to bring buyers to the Heritage that would not normally be there to see your art! And it WORKED! This year, we hope to push even harder to get more of those buyers into the Montana Miniatures room. We have a list of hundreds of buyers and will do our best to produce yet another highly successful show. After the success of the 2017 & 2018 shows, we have had a lot of artists request invitations to participate so we anticipate a lot of applicants this year and we hope you chose to participate as well. We will be shooting for roughly 150 pieces for the 2019 show and anticipate at least 250 applicants so bring your best game! Our plans are to become the premier miniature show in the country and we hope you will enjoy the journey along with us.

Below are the show particulars:

- Show held in the Lewis & Clark room at the Best Western Plus Heritage Inn in Great Falls.
- Show opens Wed evening (March 20th) and will close at 6pm on Saturday (March 23rd)
- Show format will be Silent Auction with Minimum opening bid price shown
- Bitterroot Frames will offer Absentee Bid forms for any buyers who can't attend
- Show commissions will be two tiered as follows
 - \$0 to \$4,000 =30% Commission
 - \$4001 and up =20% Commission
- Max *image* size accepted will be 12x16. Similar sizes with equal or less than 192 Sq In. will be ok (eg:11x17)
- All 2D pieces **must** include a suitable frame.
- 3D pieces should be roughly no larger than a basketball. Some exceptions may be approved...
- 1 piece only can be submitted and ALL works will be juried by an anonymous panel. In previous years, some artists had automatically met the approval guidelines. This year, **ALL works will be juried.**
- **Deadlines are as follows**
 - Submission forms WITH IMAGES by December 15th, 2018
 - Notifications will go out no later than Jan 15th, 2019
- All images submitted need to have minimum of 150 DPI and no more than 8MB.
- Each artists is responsible for all shipping costs to AND from the show. We had to ship some unsold pieces back to the artists last year and have still not received compensation...
- If a piece does not sell, you are welcome to pick up your piece immediately after the show, but Bitterroot Frames reserves the right to sell it for 30 days following the show. Last year, we sold 8 pieces after the show. We will do everything we can to promote and sell all pieces for the same commission rates as above.
